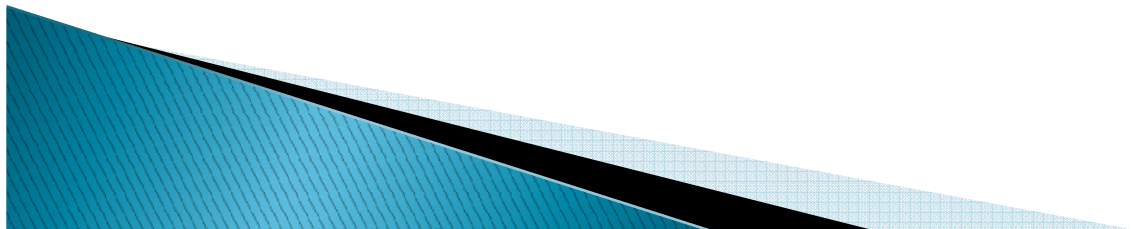

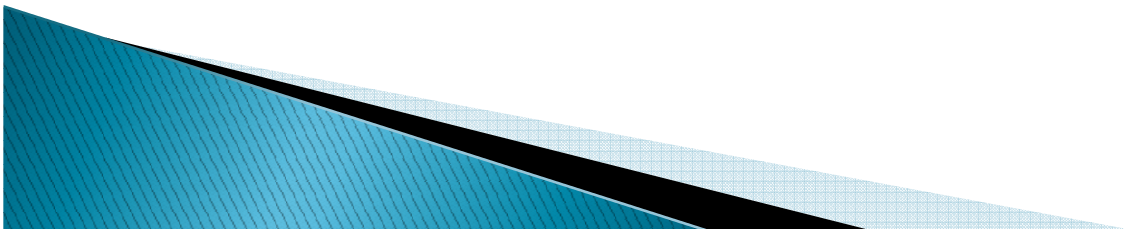
Major Events under the Satoyama Initiative

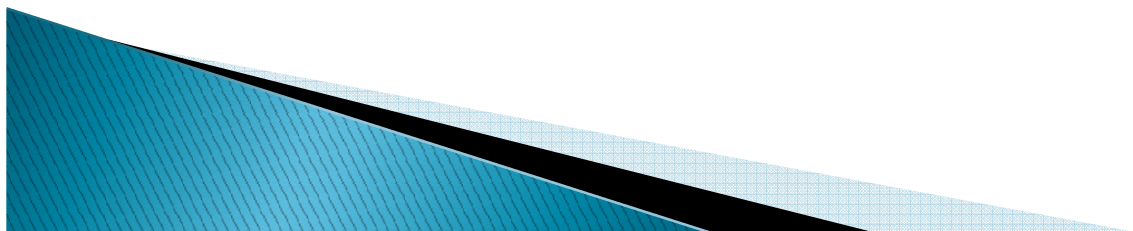

Regional Workshop in Africa 2015

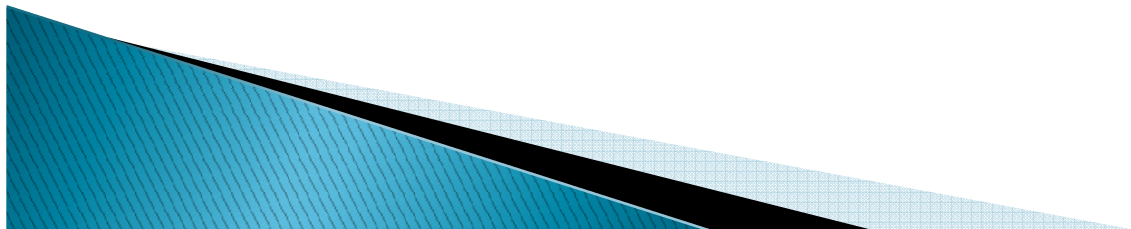
- ▶ Theme:

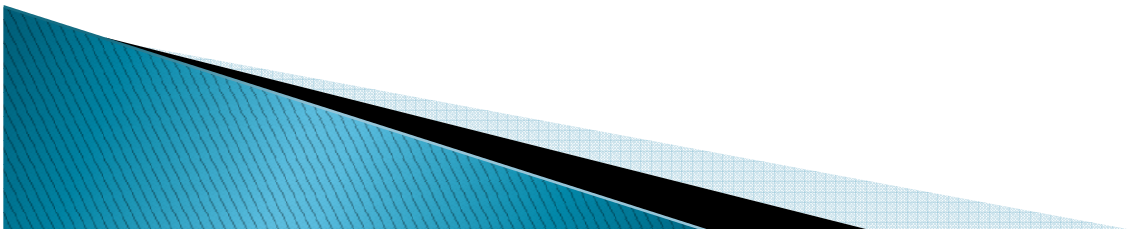
Main Questions

- ▶ What should be done for the revitalization, conservation, and sustainable management of SEPLS in Africa?



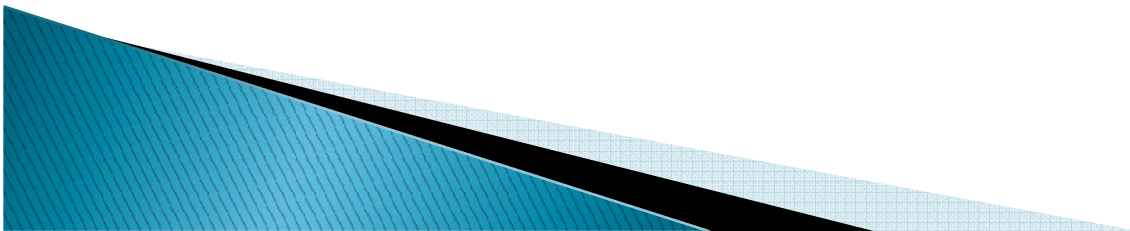
Selected Goals

- ▶ To contribute to national, regional and global policies



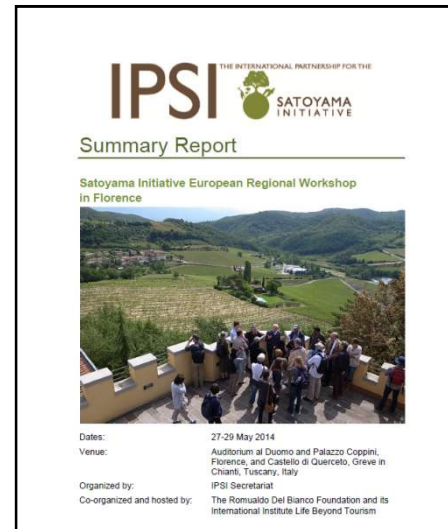

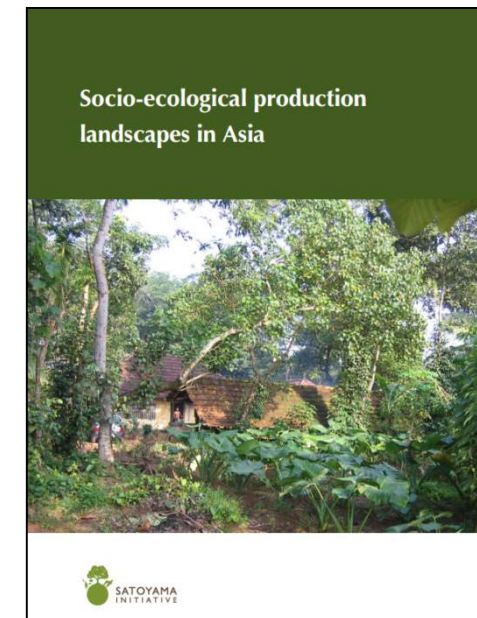
