


Background

- Joint programme on the link between biological diversity and cultural diversity by SCBD and UNESCO launched at COP10
- 1st European Conference in Florence in 2014
- 1st Asian Conference in Ishikawa in Oct.2016
 <u>Focus of Asian Conference</u>: Community revitalization though utilization and conservation of biocultural diversity

500 participants from 38 countries approved The Ishikawa Declaration

- Importance of local government to facilitate dialogue and partnership to incorporate biocultural approach in SDGs














The path forward towards 2020


