Developing a One Health preventative alert system

Ongoing (UNU-IAS, RESTEC, Japan: in collaboration with SCBD, WHO, WOAHA, UNEP, The Nature Conservancy)

Seeks to develop a Digital Public Infrastructure that focuses on the preventative aspects of One Health – linked to good environmental, agricultural, livestock management practices, and ensuring human rights are secured. (aligned with Landscape Approaches)

Idea is to eventually develop an early signaling system that can indicate perceived disruptions to allow planners to take timely actions.
