Major Actions (Planning, Knowledge, Capacity)

Integrated restoration planning and coordination (PA 1)

- Conduct species inventories and mapping to prioritize restoration
- Co-develop restoration plans with communities and stakeholders
- Strengthen cross-sectoral and inclusive collaboration

Knowledge integration (PA 2)

- Integrate diverse knowledge system
- Establish baseline data and data-sharing platforms
- Document and share restoration practices and lessons learned

Capacity development (PA 3)

- Provide training, peer learning, and knowledge exchange
- Strengthen capacity of communities, youth, and restoration actors

Major Actions (Implementation and Scaling)

Community-led restoration and enabling conditions (PA 5)

- Support community-led restoration and sustainable land use
- Strengthen partnerships and financial support mechanisms
- Link restoration with sustainable livelihoods

Monitoring, communication, and scaling (PA 4 & 6)

- Establish long-term monitoring and evaluation systems
- Promote knowledge exchange, awareness, and restoration networks
- Align SEPLS restoration with global restoration and biodiversity goals
